Summer Worship Schedule Sundays at 9:30 a.m. through September 10th. 9 and 10:30 a.m. services resume on September 17th.

Therefore GO! These are the marching orders of the great commission, as Jesus passes the torch of leadership onto his disciples. In that same spirit, we as LPUMC, are beginning a new season of ministry. On July 23, a specially called charge conference passed unanimously that LPUMC shifts to the United Methodist-approved model of governance known as the Simplified Accountability Structure.

Now that we are moving in this new direction, the next phase falls to the LPUMC nominations committee. This committee is seeking nine disciples to serve on the *Leadership Board* and six disciples to help discern future board members on the *Nominations and Leadership Development Committee*. What we as the entire congregation of LPUMC are now discerning, is who would be on our dream team to help lead the church forward in the fruitful growth of its ministries. Who has a passion for helping lead LPUMC in such a way that we continue to grow and build on our current energy? As these nominees will be both stewards of church resources, as well as those visioning for the future health of LPUMC, the nominations committee is looking to identify disciples who are earnest in their faith journeys and possess a missional heart to make an impact in the world of Jesus Christ.


The current nomination committee is encouraging church members to fill out the **Leadership Board Interest Form**. Even if you may not have an interest at this time serving on the leadership board, the nomination committee would be interested in hearing where you have experience and in serving. One of the main reasons for moving to the Simplified Accountability Structure is that the model frees up more church members from serving on administrative committees so that more time and energy might be devoted to mission and outreach. The other benefits of this model are that it improves efficiency and streamlines the decision-making process. This new model still relies on church volunteers and leadership; however, it allows for more members to become involved with short-term tasks. While one may not feel led to express interest in the board, they may be willing to offer their talents in the short term elsewhere.

In addition to the leadership board, please let the nominations committee know what secular skills might be suited for serving on a ministry team.
